	TREATS PARTICIPANTS WITH RESPECT
	▶ Keep your opinions (and politics) to yourself
1	The only one you can make fun of is yourself
	Multicultural - be careful
	► No yelling, NO SWEARING at all
	You are not that important
	PROFESSIONAL IN APPEARANCE AND MANNERISM; ETHICAL
	► How is your energy and enthusiasm
7	They can "dress down" not the instructor!
	► Look presentable – No wild outfits that distract
	► ETHICS
	▶ DO NOT STEAL artwork, photos
	WORKS WITHIN HIS OR HER PERSONALITY
	Not funny? Don't tell jokes
3	▶ Don't fake your lack of knowledge
	▶ Don't try to sound smarter than you are
	Be kind, Be yourself
	▶ Do not stand behind classroom – be in front – EYE CONTACT
	CREATES AN INVITING LEARNING ATMOSPHERE
	▶ Lighting, Temperature

	STATES THE OBJECTIVE UP FRONT
	State it first to participants
6	► Keep it simple
	► Stick with it – don't vary
	► Know the Objective <u>BEFORE</u> you train
	► Comment – is your objective understood?
	ORGANIZED PRESENTATION
	Design your PowerPoint - don't decorate! Just a tool
7	Logical order
	Simple and clean - Not wordy
	DO not read it -Do not turn your back to the audience
	Remove slides not using
	TELLS A GOOD (RELEVANT) STORY
	Must be relevant to the training
Q	► Keep it short
	Don't know of any? Find some
	▶ Warning – don't steal an antidote & pretend it happened to you
	▶ Do no harm
	VARIES THE INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNIQUES
	Don't just lecture
	Group discussion or group exercises
	Table top workshops
	Take a field trip or Demonstrations
	▶ Use props
	FOLLOWS THE GOLDEN TRAINING RULE THE THREE 'S'
	▶ Be a people watcher, not a clock watcher.
